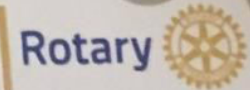

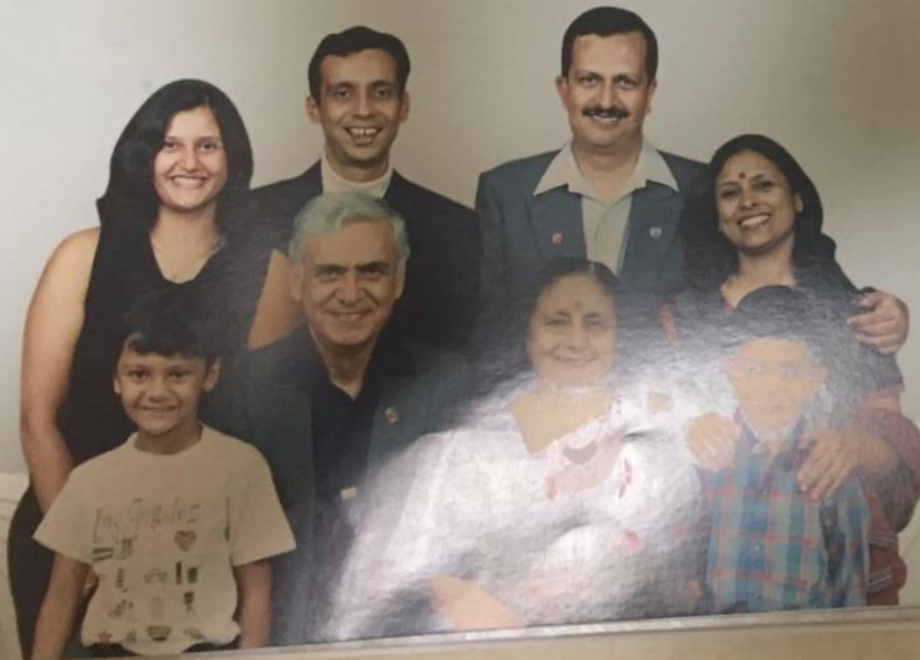

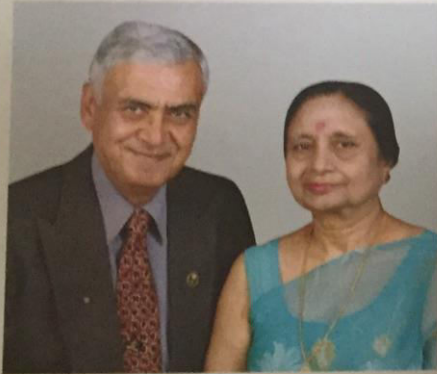

RTN O P KHANNA

He has been a Rotarian for over 41 years. Only Rotarian in Dist 3190 to have started three Endowment Funds.



Mr Khanna is a graduate engineer from IIT Kharagpur, then the only IIT in India, and post graduate from Halle, Germany. He is a Chartered Engineer in UK and has been awarded Fellowship by four Professional Institutions in India, UK and Germany.

During his professional span of 54 years in industry, he has been Chairman, MD, and CEO of multinational corporations for over 16 years. He had the opportunity to be associated with some of the top names in industry- like JRD Tata, Moolgaonkar, C K Birla, L M Thapar, Ratan Tata, Arvind Mafatlal etc. during his

work tenure. He has extensively traveled to other countries (47 countries). He is past Chairman of CII, Central Gujarat, and National Chairman of Indian Institution of Production Engineers; and has been / is on managing committee of many other national and state level professional bodies. He has been involved in turnaround of three large manufacturing Companies.

Currently, besides being on the Board of over a dozen organizations, he spends part of his time with some professional bodies in advisory capacity and balance time with four NGOs; ---"Organizing Heart Surgeries for the needy poor heart patients"; Rehabilitation of destitute children & destitute seniors; Vocational training of poor school/college drop outs. He also gives free consultation to needy sick units aspiring for turnaround.

Rtn Khanna has been recipient of 7 international like Carl Benz and Takraf Gold medal in Germany, "Pride of Asia" Gold Medal in Singapore, Service above Self (RI) etc., & 14 national awards like Udyog Rattan, Hind Rattan, Sir Visvesvaraya etc. and many Rotary awards in India.

He has been a Rotarian for over 41 years - was first invited in 1974 to be a member by Rotary Pimpri Chinchwad, followed by Bangalore Indiranagar, Baroda (India) and Lugazi Uganda. He has visited 48 clubs abroad and has provided home hospitality to about 36 Rotarians from other districts so far.

He was President of Rotary Club of Bangalore Indiranagar, in 1986/87 and since then held 18 District Chairman/ Director Positions. He was the Dist Conf Chairman-Dist. 3190 twice, first in 1989-90 that was the largest Conference in District 3190 in India so far, with 3485 registrations; and second in the Rotary Centenary year- both held at Bangalore palace grounds.

He is a level 4 Major Donor & AKS member. He is the only Rotarian in Dist 3190 to have started three Endowment Funds -one for Needy Heart Surgeries, the second for needy destitute Children and third for Vocational Training of needy drop outs.

His daughter Mini and son Ashish were presidents of Interact/Rotract clubs in 1980s.
